## **Organist - Part Time**

Church of the Holy Trinity in Georgetown, Kentucky seeks a talented and enthusiastic organist (part time) to help lead our music ministry. This person will play the organ and piano during the Sunday morning service at 10:30am and other services that are part of the church's liturgical life including Holy Days, funerals, weddings, Evensongs, and other special services. During the choral year (Late August-May), they will work with the choir director in planning music for upcoming services and play during weekly Sunday rehearsals.

Holy Trinity is an Episcopal parish in the heart of fast-growing Georgetown, Kentucky. Our congregation enjoys a variety of musical styles from those rooted in the Anglican tradition to music that reflects our Appalachian roots. We use music from *The Hymnal 1982*, *Lift Every Voice and Sing II*, and *Wonder, Love, and Praise*. Our choir currently consists of a handful of dedicated parishioners as well as four paid choral scholars (must be full-time students).

### Responsibilities

- Playing the organ and piano for 10:30am Sunday Eucharist and other special services, including but not limited to weddings, funerals, evensongs, and other services.
- Playing for 9:45am and 12:00pm rehearsals during the choral year (Late Aug-May)
- Playing for choral scholar auditions as needed.
- Working collaboratively with clergy and the choir director to select appropriate music, building on our Anglican tradition as well as incorporating new styles into the worship service.
- Fostering congregational singing
- Coordinating instrument maintenance: 1942 Two-manual Aeolian-Skinner and Steinway Grand Piano
- Assist in securing professional musicians for special services.
- Arranging for a substitute when unavailable for a regular or special service of the church.
- Complete and maintain all training and instruction as required by the Diocese of Lexington and The Episcopal Church.

#### **Qualifications and Skills**

- Proficiency in organ/music performance with a commitment to quality in liturgical worship.
- Knowledge and familiarity with traditional sacred music and Episcopal liturgical practice, as well as a willingness to explore non-traditional musical offerings for worship.
