Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide organ music weekly for Sunday morning service (10:15am) and seasonal mid-week services (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week).
 - Hymn selections made by the Pastor. Organist's choice for Prelude and Postlude music given alignment with traditional service (J.S. Bach anyone?).
- Seasonally rehearse with the choir on organ or piano, as scheduled (normally immediately before or after church service).
- Inform the Pastor and Elders of maintenance needs for the organ.
- Assist in finding a substitute organist when unavailable.

- \$150 per service

Other Details

- First refusal rights for weddings, funerals, or other special services.
- Traditional Lutheran (LCMS) liturgy and hymns.
 - Currently using the Lutheran Service Book, released by Concordia Publishing House in 2005. There is a copy of the Lutheran Service Book Accompaniment Edition as well as a manual for the organ.
- Occasional collaboration with the volunteer choir and Choir Director along with instrumental and vocal soloists. Choral music is selected by the Choir Director.
 - Choir does not rehearse every week, only when preparing for services. Rehearsals are approximately 1 hour and take place either immediately before or after the church service.
- No conducting, arranging, or composing duties required.
