Greetings from the Lexington Chapter of the American Guild of Organists! My name is James Humlong, Chapter Dean, and I would like to tell you about a very exciting opportunity for your piano students ages 11 to 18. Our chapter will be hosting a "Pedals, Pipes, and Pizza", a **free** one-day event to introduce young people to the pipe organ.

This event will take place on Saturday, February 2, 2019, from 9:30am to 1:30pm. We will begin at First Presbyterian Church, where there will be an organ demonstration. The students will then be guided across the street to Christ Church Cathedral to see and tour the pipe organ there. We will have a pizza lunch and finish the day in the chapel at First Presbyterian, where they have a third pipe organ to experience. We will also have a guest speaker, David Schroth, of D. C. Schroth Organ Builders in Louisville to explain the mechanics and functions of the organ.

Students are encouraged to bring along a piano piece to play on the organ to see the difference between the two instruments. If you have students who are interested, please have them fill out the attached form and either mail it to me or scan and email it to me no later than January 25th. Thank you for your consideration and the work you do for our young musicians. Feel free to contact me if you have any questions or would like more information.
